- thrust

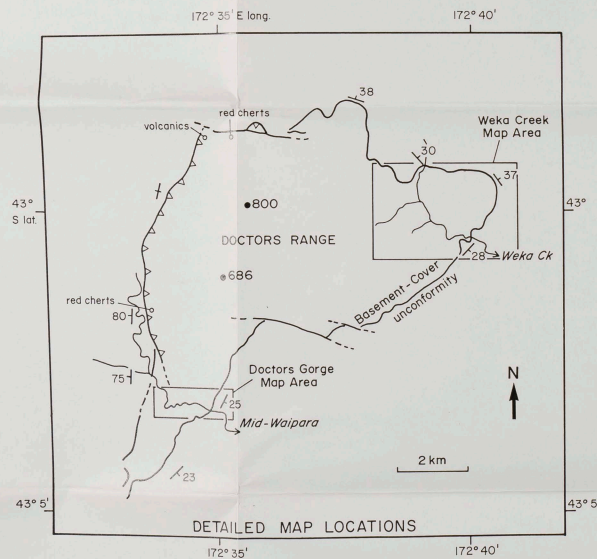
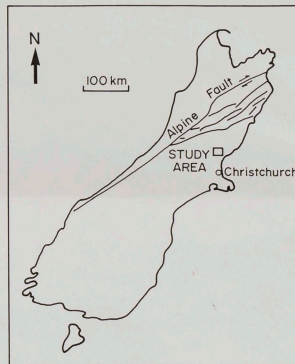
CULTURAL

LITHOLOGIES

- thick (>1m) massive sandstone beds
- interbedded sandstone and mudstones
- mudstone beds
- red chert and volcanic horizons
- restricted occurrences of named lithologies

Data collected by the author and D.U. Wise across several basement traverses. Thick massive sandstone beds mapped away from these traverses were located using aerial photographs (runs 1819 and 1820, 1950), verified by outcrop reconnaissance and remote (distant) field observations
